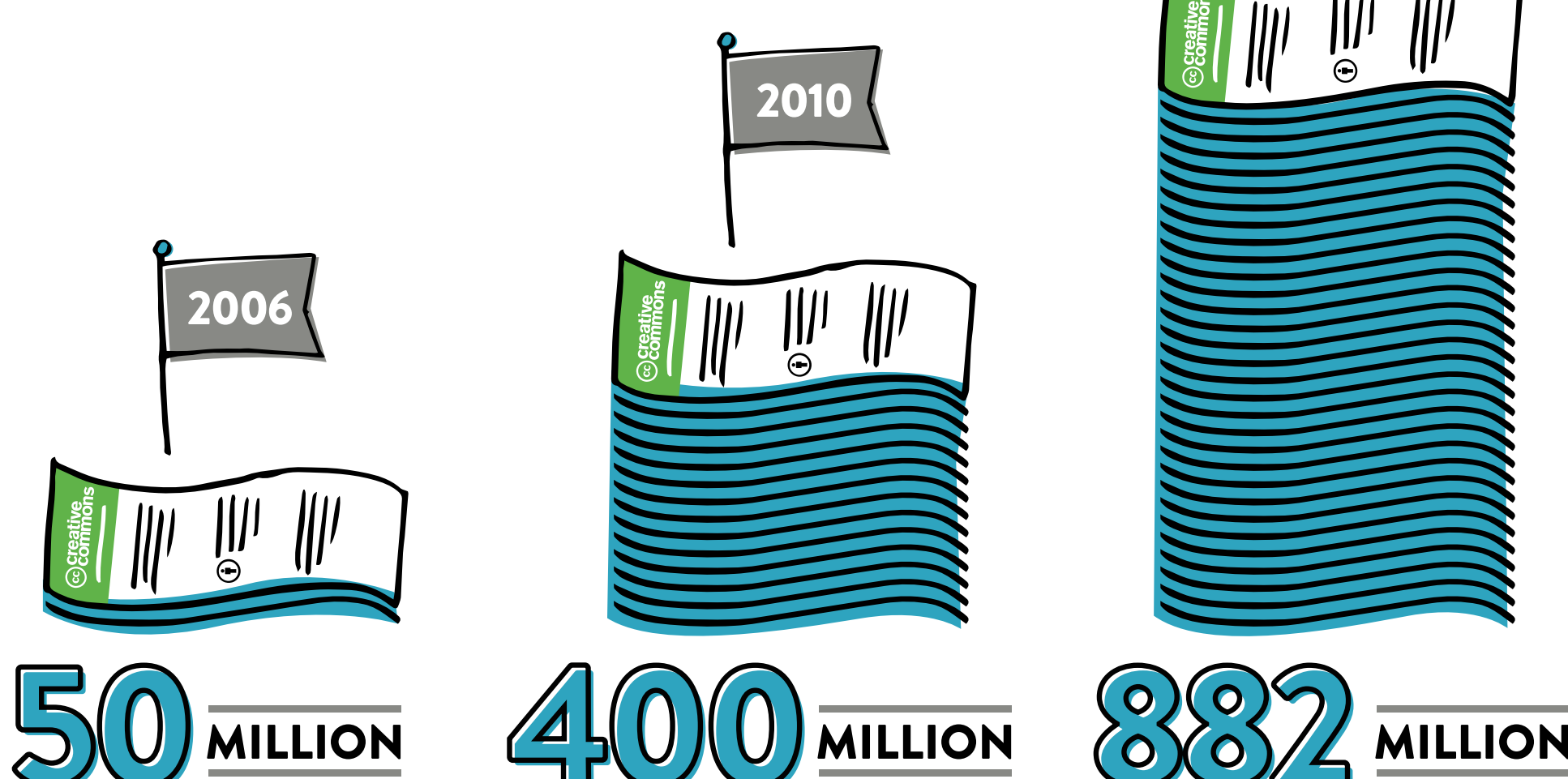


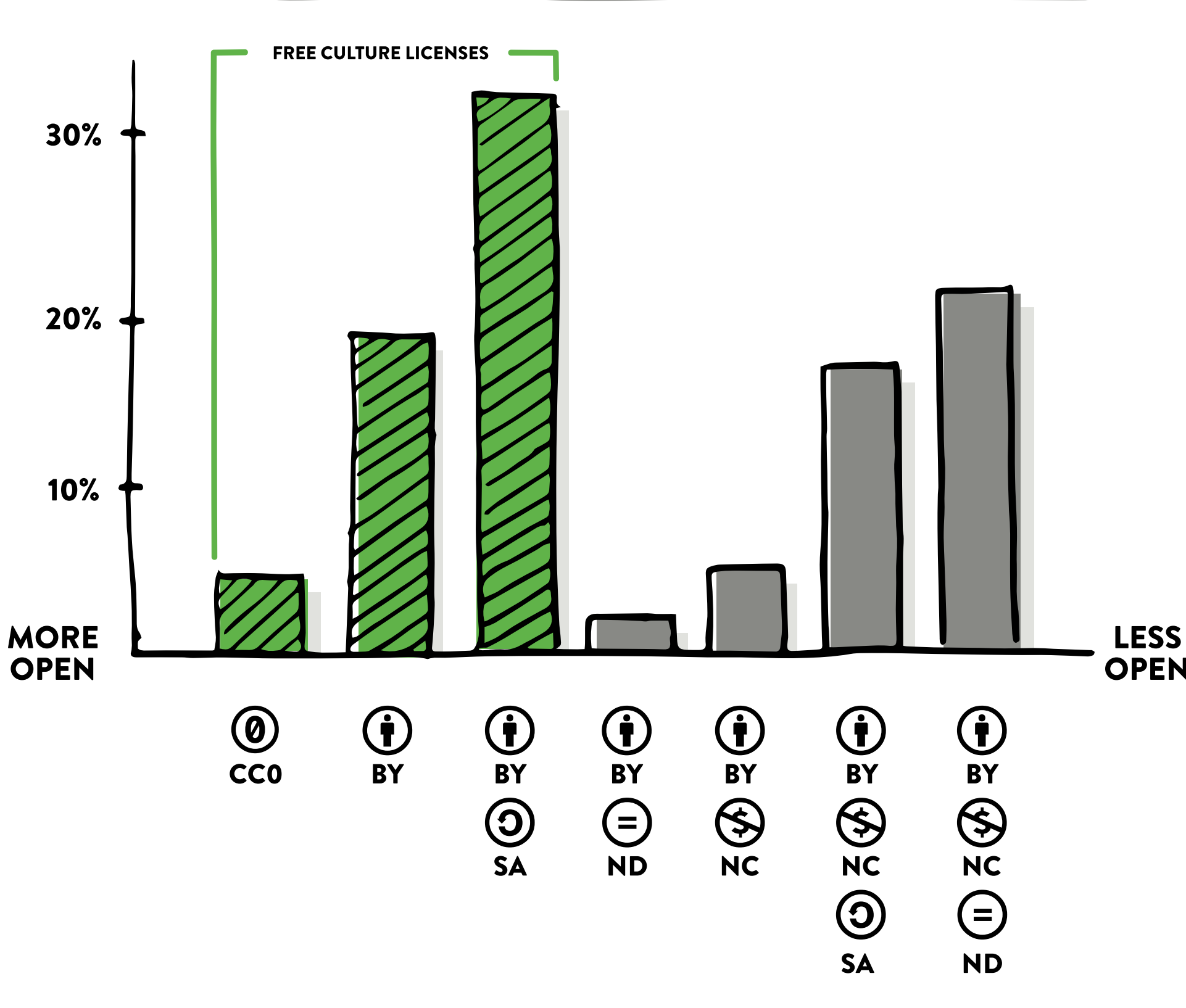
STATE OF THE COMMONS

Number of Creative Commons-licensed works

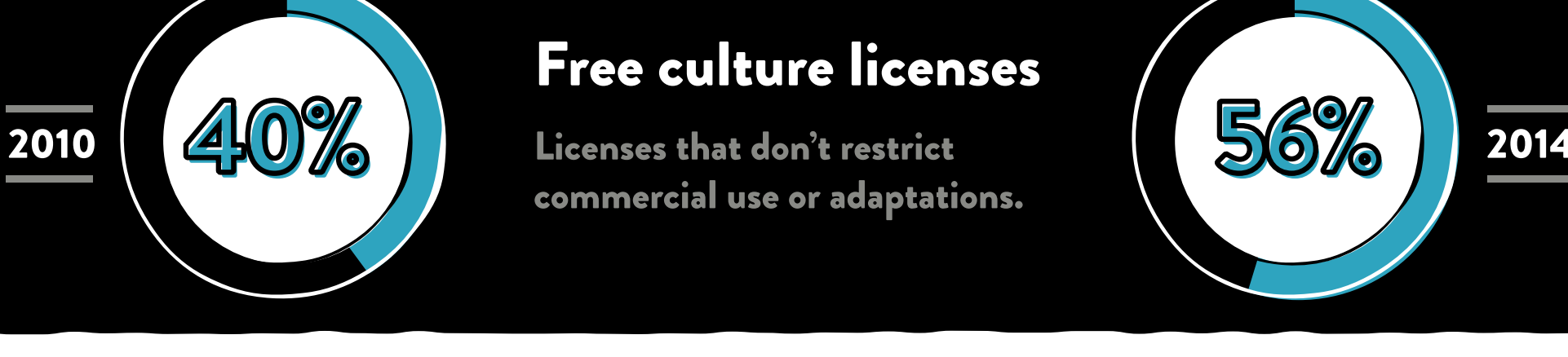


Creative Commons license use

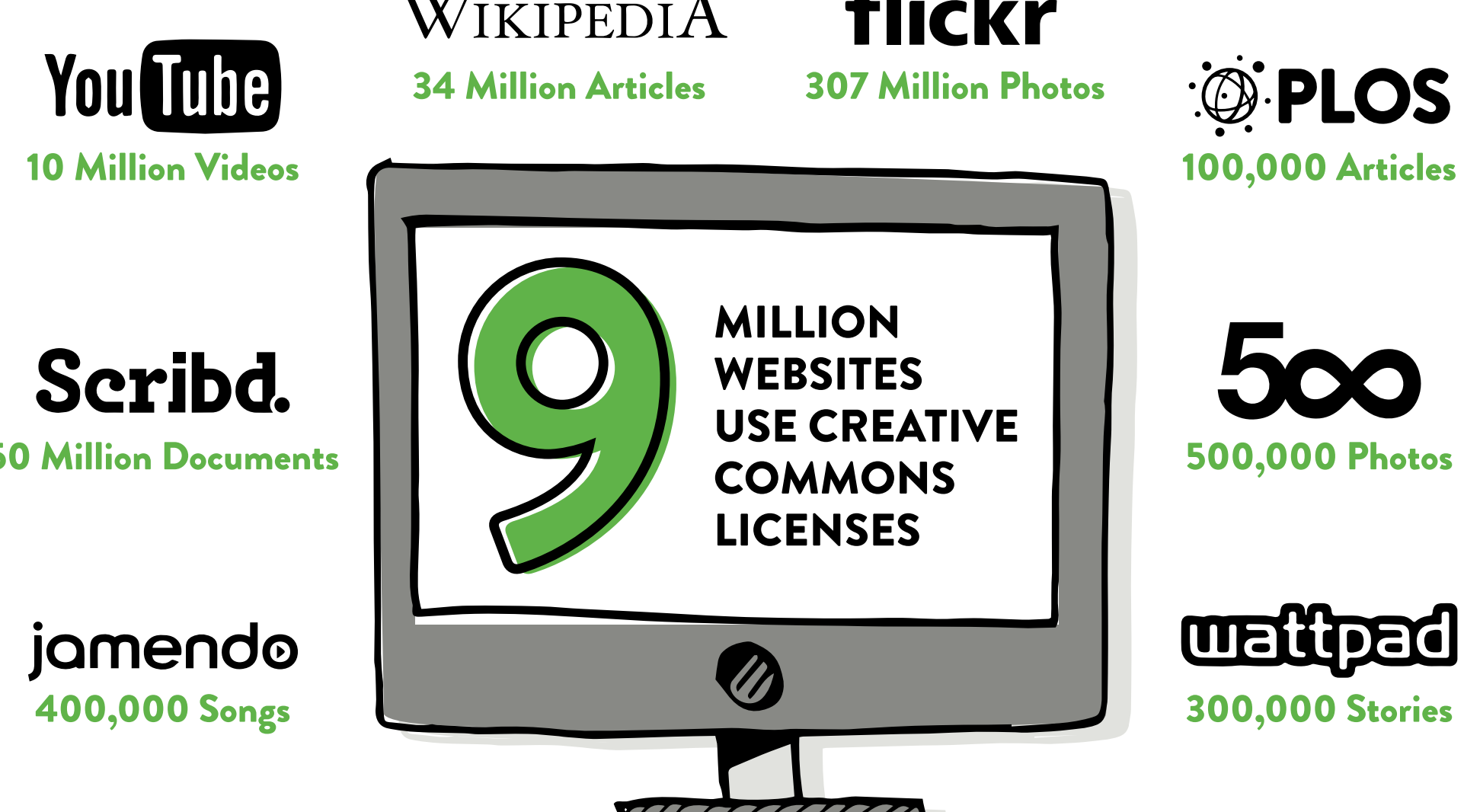
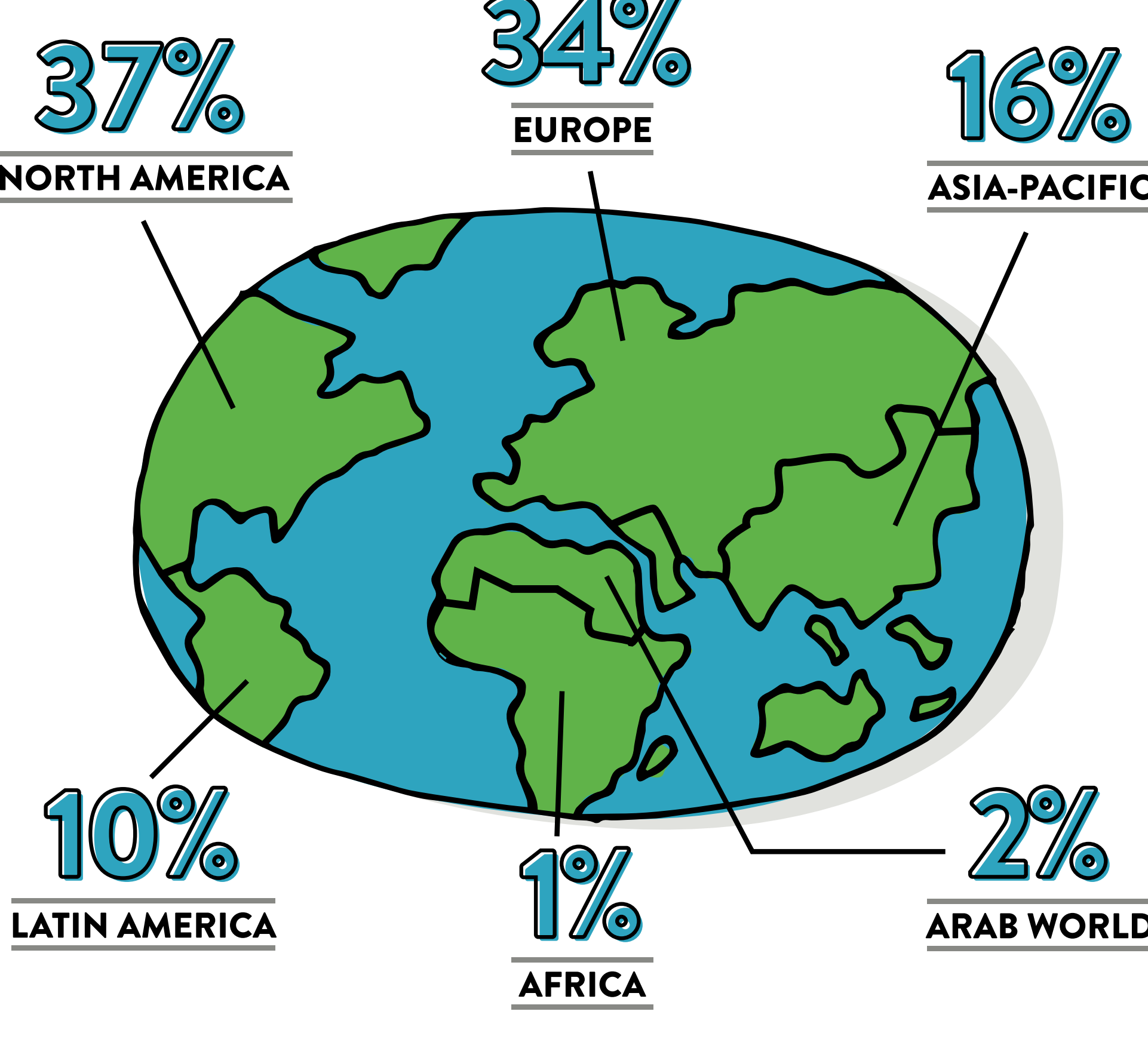

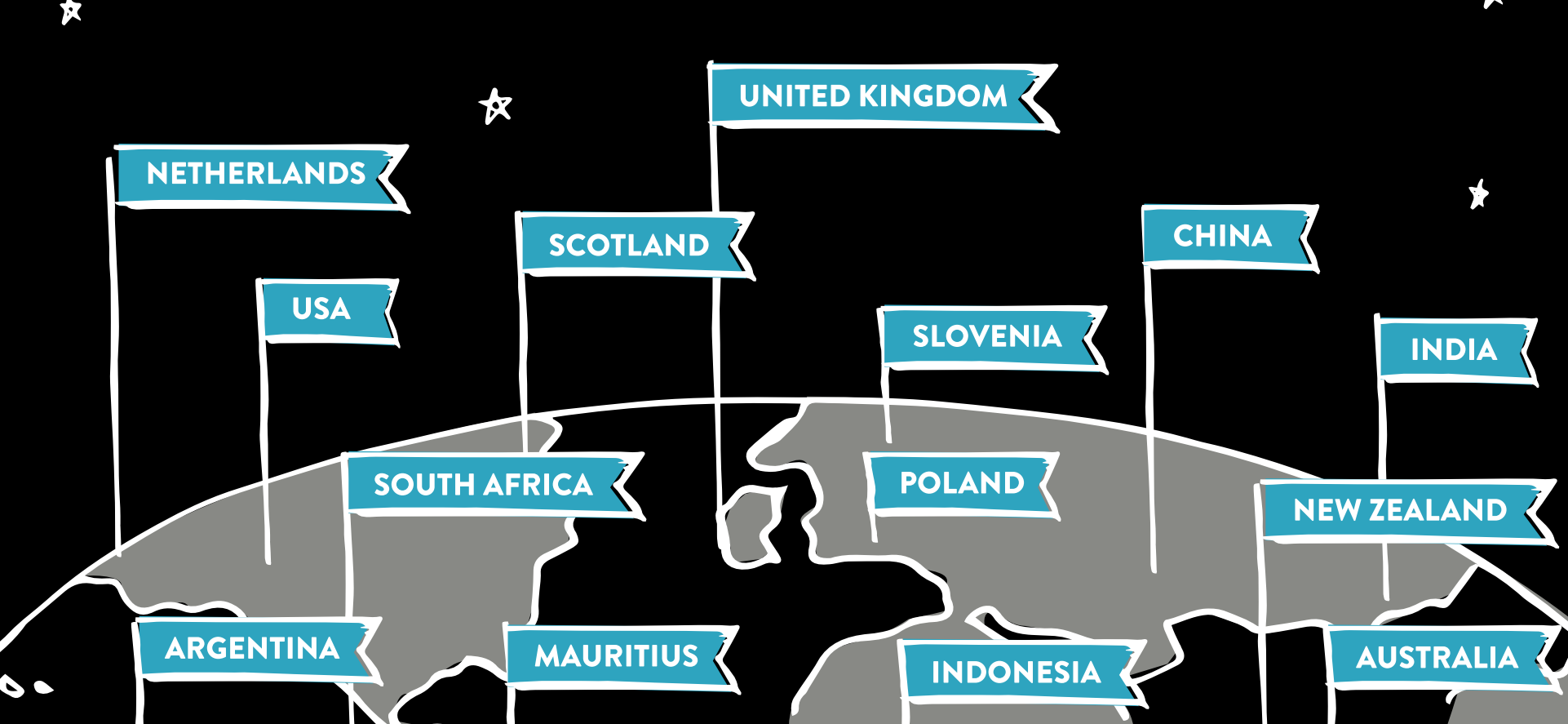
Where CC-licensed works are published
